
The City of Valladolid, as the second most important city in Yucatan and the oldest in the state, is known for its history, and its cultural and tourist attractions.

#### Location

Valladolid is situated right in the middle of the two most important cities in the Yucatan Peninsula, Merida and Cancun, both at approximately 99 miles (160 km) from Valladolid. It is bordered to the north by Temozon, to the south by Cuncunul-Tekom-Chichimila, to the east by Chemax, and to the west by Cuncunul-Uayma.

The main archeological sites of the area are located nearby: Chichen Itza, only 28 miles (45 km) away, Tulum, 62 miles (100 km), Ek Balam, 19 miles (30 km), and Coba, 22 miles (35 km).


